**WEATHER/CLIMATE**

- Situated in the heart of the west coast temperate rainforest, the weather and surrounding natural environment offer a range of experiences along with the most moderate climate in Canada. While it can rain at any time of year, our summer months are typically dry and warm. As we move into fall, rainfall slowly increases welcoming the arrival of our first big storms in early November. One may see towering 25 foot waves with streaming rooster tails being driven by 90 km per hour winds crashing against the shore and beach in front of the Inn. This time of year exemplifies our local west coast saying, "There is no such thing as bad weather, just bad clothing." In the spring, warmer temperatures begin in early March with daffodils signaling the start of annual bird migrations and arrival of the Grey Whales.
